- You can only earn MP Points for points PAST required class assignments (practice time is applied to assignments FIRST)
- Put all extra minutes on your monthly practice logs. When logs are graded, extra minutes become MP Points.

30 Minutes Helping a Middle Schooler - 20 points

- There will also be specific days on the calendar before large events where you can mentor a student. You will need to sign up in advance.
- Filling in on a concert counts similarly

30 Minute Private Lesson – 30 points

- Your private teacher will be contacted for verification.
- Can include virtual lessons.
- Private lesson logs are available on Google Classroom.
- Private lessons can be used for regular practice log time if needed. In that case, they would NOT count for MP Points.

Other

Tri-M Music Honor Society Member - 50 points (not available every year)

- If you get suspended or do not complete your hours for the year, you will lose these points.

Attend a "Band Day", Instrument Day, Clinic, or Weekend Camp - 50 points

Student Planned Community Performance (nursing home, elementary event, hospital, etc.) – 25 points per 30 min

Work a School Music Related Event (Solo & Ensemble, Concert Festival, Band Room Clean-Up, etc.) - 20 points per hour

NOTE: Fundraiser participation CANNOT earn MP Points per IRS regulations. Also, if you turn it in for Tri-M hours, it CANNOT count for MP Points.
